

# 2022 Woonsocket Water Festival

## "Kings of Crash" Power Wheels Derby

### Rules:

1. \$10.00 entry fee.
2. Ages 3-10 only, split into 2 divisions: 3-5 and 6-10
3. Any regular electric power wheels allowed. NO 4-wheeler type vehicles or ones where child's legs are not inside compartment. Vehicles must be ride in, not ride on.
4. Helmets are required and must always be worn. Acceptable helmets: bike helmets, football helmets, and motorcycle helmets.
5. Drivers must wear eye protection safety glasses, goggles, or helmets with visors
6. Seat belts are not mandatory but recommended.
7. The electric motors must be stock
8. Battery can be upgraded to lawn mower sized battery or 500ca. Battery must be mounted inside, covered and sealed away from the child. **Battery cannot be on the seat next to them.**
9. All doors, hoods, tailgates, and anything that can come open or flop around need to be secured with duct tape, rope, bungee straps, or sip ties. No sharp edges and no wire can be exposed.
10. Tires are to be stock tires. Parents may cover them in duct tape to keep them together. No traction adders: i.e., nails, screws or rubber.
11. All power wheels are to be factory height. Any car too big or heavy will be addressed in the pit before event.
12. Decorations can be added to each car but cannot be used to strengthen the car and cannot have a sharp edge. No metal, wire, or screws to be used anywhere on the car unless it is factory.
13. Recommended to put a number on each entered car
14. Four balloons will be added to the power wheel. Whoever has the most balloons after 10 mins the drove and participated in the event is the winner. Tie breaker will be left to judges.
15. Must have a parent or guardian to sign liability waver for child and only one parent or guardian needs to be in the pit with child. Parents must stay out of the derby bounds. We will have judges and volunteers available to help kids inside the barrier.
16. Power wheels will be inspected at the gate and impounded until time for event. The inspection crew will have the final say if it runs or not.
17. This is for fun. Parents, we ask that you let the kids have fun. Show them good sportsmanship.
